Where can I find a map of the City of Pinckneyville?

Stop by the Police Department, the Chamber of Commerce Building, or the Pinckneyville City Hall Annex all located on Walnut Street, North of the four-way stoplight.

What are the curfew laws in Pinckneyville?

According to State law, an Illinois Driver's License expires between the hours of 10:00pm – 6:00am Sunday through Thursday nights and 11:00 pm – 6:00 am Friday and Saturday nights for those 16 years of age who are licensed drivers.

City ordinance states that it is unlawful for a person less than 17 years of age to be at any public place unless accompanied and supervised by a parent, legal guardian or other responsible companion who is at least 18 years of age and is approved by a parent or guardian after the following hours. City curfew hours are Friday and Saturday nights between the hours of 12:01 am and 6:00 am Sunday through Thursday nights between the hours of 11:00 pm and 6:00 am. Anyone caught violating this ordinance is subject to a fine.

Who do I call if there is a dog running loose in my neighborhood?

If inside the city limits, contact the Pinckneyville Police Department at 357-8231.

All incidents outside of city limits contact the Perry County Animal Control at 357-2841. The city's animal ordinance is available for you to view on this site.

How do I report suspicious / illegal activity in my neighborhood?

The Pinckneyville Police Department values any information from the community that is of a suspicious nature, especially any activity involving drugs, gangs, or weapons. How do I report a loud music / party complaint?

Contact Pinckneyville Police Department at 357-8231, or call 911. Give the telecommunicator as much information concerning address, vehicle description, and type of activity as is available.

How do I obtain an order of protection?

Contact your local law enforcement agency, or you county state's attorney's office. In Pinckneyville, you can contact the Perry County State's Attorney's Office at 357-6221.

When is Trick or Treat?

Trick or Treat is determined yearly at the city council meetings and is listed on our City website calendar. Pinckneyville Trick or Treat is for Children ages 13 & under from 5:00 – 9:00 pm. Please be considerate and only visit houses that have their porch lights on.
